Goal of work session:

Goal is to determine a line of communication to deliver to the public about the annexation, develop agenda for joint meeting with the City Council and County Court, and determine the best path forward in expanding the District boundaries.

1. Set ground rules and time limits for work session:
2. Plan out the annexation timeline and process: Review report from Eileen Eakins.
 - a. Public strategy and outreach efforts.
 - b. Letter of the CCPRD Board's intent to annex new territory (By annexing in the majority of the county population we are providing the opportunity for them to use our parks and amenities. The goal is to have all potential users share in the cost of this community benefit).
3. Develop questions and issues that the CCPRD Board intends to address with the County Court / City Council during our joint meeting later in June:
 - a. Is Crook County willing to put forth a bond measure to construct a new pool?
 - b. Is Crook County willing to support CCPRD in their efforts to annex to the Fire District boundaries?
 - c. Will Crook County initiate the annexation process for the district?
 - d. Will Crook County support or oppose if the citizens initiated the formation of new parks and rec district by petition?
 - e. Do you want to ask the Crook County Court (again) if they would be willing to initiate the formation of a new parks and recreation district? Address the sentiment of taxation without representation?
 - f. Is Crook County willing to support either the construction of a new pool or the operations of a new pool financially? If yes how much?
 - g. Is the City Council willing to support the construction or operation of a new pool? Is so how much?
 - h. Sell lowering of the tax rate to the current taxpayers and encouraging the new areas that the lower tax rate benefits everyone.
 - i. If we dissolved and reformed we should consider two options: current fire boundaries or the whole county for our district.
4. Discuss ramifications if the annexation passes:
 - a. pool bond proposal
 - b. operational funding for the pool

- c. 5 year plan for the new areas added from the annexation
5. Discuss ramification if the annexation does not pass:
- a. reorganize and prioritize to operate within the current boundaries with the current budget.
 - b. change fee schedule for out of district individuals
