Note:

The Crook County Parks and Recreation District Board of Directors is interested in meeting with the Pool Advisory Committee to discuss the construction and operations of new indoor pool.

It has become apparent that at this time, CCPRD is too small to reasonably put forth a bond proposal to build an indoor pool and they do not have the financial capacity to operate it. A tax levy to fund the operations of the pool is not feasible due to tax compression issues. Unless the district increases in size, or alternative funding is secured, the district cannot move forward with this project. For this reason the CCPRD Board is wondering to what degree of “grass roots” support the Pool Advisory Committee would provide to help educate the community about these issues. The CCPRD Board will come prepared to share what they have been working on, what funds are available to help develop a plan, and what they can do to support this process.
